

## Grow your business with Government Contracting



**Register** your business on the **HUD Business Registry** for contracts receiving U.S. Department of Housing & Urban Development (HUD) funding.

The **HUD Business Registry** is a searchable online database of self-certified Section 3 businesses. It is used by agencies, developers, contractors, and others that receive HUD funds to locate Section 3 Businesses for certain HUD-funded projects.

To self-certify as a Section 3 Business (see definition below) register at **HUD's Business Registry**: <https://portalapps.hud.gov/Sec3BusReg/BRegistry/RegisterBusiness>



**A Section 3 Business** meets *at least one* of the following criteria (documented within the last 6-month period):



- **51%** or more owned or controlled by low- or very low-income individuals
- **75%** of labor hours performed for the business over the prior 3-month period are performed by low- and very low-income persons
- **51%** or more owned and controlled by current public housing or residents who currently live in Section 8-assisted housing
